Clean Slate Program: How to Apply

STEP 1: Get your San Francisco Criminal History (SF RAP sheet)

Visit the SF Police Department ID Bureau at **850 Bryant St., Room 475**, M-F from 8am-3pm. The RAP sheet is free. Bring a valid photo ID.

Mail (1) a notarized request for your RAP sheet including your name, any aliases, date of birth, and social security number, (2) a copy of your valid state ID, and (3) a self addressed stamped envelope to: SF Police Department, ID Bureau, 850 Bryant St., Room 475, San Francisco, CA 94103.

STEP 2: Fill out a Clean Slate Application

Clean Slate Program: How We Can Help

☑ Dismiss Convictions

If you were convicted of a crime **in San Francisco** and put on probation for that crime, we may be able to get that conviction dismissed. If you get a conviction dismissed, then on most job applications you can legally say you were not convicted of that crime. To qualify for a dismissal you **cannot** be (1) serving a sentence, (2) on probation or parole, or (3) currently charged with a crime. Even if your case is dismissed, employers may still be able to see the incident on your record, however, there will be a notation that says 'dismissed.'

☑ Obtain a Certificate of Rehabilitation

If you were convicted of a crime **in San Francisco** and you were sentenced to State Prison for that crime, we cannot get that conviction dismissed, but we may be able to get you a Certificate of Rehabilitation. If (1) you currently **live in San Francisco**, (2) have been in California for the past five years and (3) have been out of custody for at least seven years, you may qualify for a Certificate of Rehabilitation.

☑ Reduce some Felonies to Misdemeanors

If you were convicted of a felony "wobbler", we may be able to reduce that felony to a misdemeanor.

☑ End Probation Early

If you are on probation in San Francisco, we may be able to end your probation early.

☑ Seal and Destroy some Arrest Records

If you were wrongfully stopped or arrested in San Francisco, we may be able to get your detention or arrest record sealed and destroyed. To qualify for sealing and destroying your arrest record you have to (1) be able to prove you are innocent of the crimes you were arrested for, (2) not be convicted of those crimes, and (3) make the request within two years of the arrest (unless there is a good reason for your delay).
