

1 **Statement of Stanley Harris**

3 Q: Jeff Adachi

4 A: Stanley Harris

6 Q: Hold on one second. Um, okay. This is—what's your name, please?

7 A: My name is Stanley Harris.

8 Q: And where are you right now?

9 A: I am on the 7th floor in 850 Bryant Street.

10 Q: Okay. And can you please tell us what happened to you?

11 A: I—well, well, uh, while I'm incarcerated, Deputy Neu make me fight another individual
12 that we're—we're housed in the same tank. He make us fight. We had like two fights
13 already. It's like, uh, he would make us go to like a—like a (inaudible) to where nobody
14 can see, and he make us just wrestle and fight each other to his own entertainment.

15 Q: Okay. And what are they doing, um, while you are fighting? Are they. . .

16 A: They're just standing there chanting like get him, get him, hit him, uh, fuck him up, or kick
17 him in the nuts, stuff like that.

18 Q: Okay. And who is the person that you have been fighting or that they, they forced you to
19 fight?

20 A: Ricardo Palikiko Garcia.

21 Q: Okay. And did you want to fight this person?

22 A: No, not at all.

23 Q: Okay. Did the deputies, um, force you to do this?

24 A: Yes.

25 Q: How did they force you to do this?

26 A: Threatening. He threatened to handcuff and beat me up. He said he'd put me in like a
27 holding tank, handcuff me and fuck me up—

28 Q: Okay.

1 A: —if I don't do it. And he also—he also threatened and wrote me up and sent me out to San
2 Bruno to like a hole.

3 Q: And these threats were made to you by who?

4 A: Deputy Neu.

5 Q: Okay. Were there other deputies that were involved?

6 A: Really it was just two that was a witness. They weren't really involved. They were just
7 watching it. I guess you can say that they was involved, but they didn't—they didn't make
8 me do it. It was just Deputy Neu. And the deputies that was there, that witnessed, was
9 Deputy Jones and Deputy Chiba.

10 Q: Okay. But they were present when this was going on?

11 A: They was present.

12 Q: And when did this occur? Do you remember the date or the month?

13 A: Uh, I want to say the first event occurred March 3rd or 4th, around that area. And the
14 second event occurred about a week and a half after that.

15 Q: Okay. Um, were you hurt at all in either fight?

16 A: Huh?

17 Q: Were you injured or hurt at all in either fight?

18 A: I wasn't badly (inaudible) injured or hurt but, you know, I kind of bumped—you know,
19 bumped my head a little bit and, you know, kinda hurt my, uh, my bones a little bit. But I
20 wasn't badly hurt.

21 Q: Was there any money involved or betting involved?

22 A: Yeah, but it wasn't with money. It was like kinda with food. You know, he, uh, "I got a
23 cheeseburger if you whoop his ass" or, you know, "I'll take care of you if you fuck him
24 up."

25 Q: Okay. It's—

26 A: Not like (inaudible) it's—it was using this as his own entertainment.

27 Q: Where—do you know if the deputies were betting any money?

28 A: I'm not sure. I can't really say.

1 Q: Okay. Um, how do you feel about what happened to you?

2 A: Furious because of the other stuff he do. Like, well, today he—you know, he make me do
3 like over 200 push-ups.

4 Q: Okay. I can't hear you 'cause the phone cut out. Can you repeat that?

5 A: Like today he made me do over like 200 push-ups and (inaudible)—

6 Q: Why—

7 A: —training for another—huh?

8 Q: Why did he make you do 200 push-ups?

9 A: (Inaudible) he got to where he like—we training for another fight. He make me train for
10 another fight.

11 Q: Okay. It got cut out there just a little bit. Can you tell me again. You explained that he
12 made you do push-ups, and tell us why.

13 A: Making me do push-ups to train for another fight.

14 Q: And how many push-ups?

15 A: Training me to fight.

16 Q: And how many push-ups?

17 A: So today I did like 200. It was like within an hour.

18 Q: Okay. And how do you—how do you feel about what's happened to you?

19 A: I feel kind of embarrassed. I feel—I feel like, um, I'm not really like—I don't know how I
20 feel really about the situation. (Inaudible) like 'cause he—it's like I can't do nothing about
21 it but stand up like kinda what I'm doing now. I mean, I tell him I don't want to do it and
22 he'll make me do it. Threaten to fire me 'cause I'm working in the kitchen. He'll threaten
23 to send me out to San Bruno and to the hole or he'll just simply tell me that he'll send me
24 up in the interview room and handcuff me and fuck me up.

25 Q: Was there ever a time when he threatened to fight you?

26 A: Yes, actually has.

27 Q: And tell me what happened then.

28 A: When—during my, uh, you know, the little exercise he had me do, he'll make me get up

1 and, uh, tell me he want to go a round with me. He said let's hit—he say, uh, let's get a
2 one-minute round. He'll take off his belt, take off his shirt, and you know, he'll try to
3 make me fight him, but I never do it.

4 Q: And how many times did that happen?

5 A: Twice.

6 Q: Okay. Did he ever threaten to assault you in any other way?

7 A: He (inaudible).

8 Q: I'm sorry, it's not coming through. Hello?

9 A: He, uh, he did kind of sexually like threaten me, but it was kind of like embarrassing how
10 he saying it.

11 Q: Okay. What, what did he say this other time?

12 A: Like, I'll be doing the push-ups he making me do and he—like, he'll kinda tell me he'll
13 take my cheeks or something like that.

14 Q: What did you understand that to me?

15 A: Huh?

16 Q: What did you understand that to mean?

17 A: What did I—what did I think he meant by that?

18 Q: Yeah.

19 A: Like taking my ass or fucking me or something.

20 Q: Yeah. Okay. Hold on a second. Let me check and make sure it recorded.
